3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 750 characters)

ARCH PSH 1 Renewal requires chronic status and has 14 SRO unit configuration. ARCH commits to Housing First and makes no requirement of clients for placement in particular units in accordance with client choice. Single Room Occupancy is essentially a group home situation, and many clients who meet the definition of chronically homeless do not want to live in this setting. Additionally, 2019 PIT count demonstrated only 13% Chronically Homeless, indicating 87% in need of RRH (non-chronic). ARCH CA encouraged CoC-funded Legacy Provider in particular and other PSH providers to reallocate a portion of PSH to RRH without success. ARCH voluntarily reallocated \$98,455 PSH 1 combined with \$41,135 Bonus funding to create a new RRH project to address lack of RRH for non-chronics.
